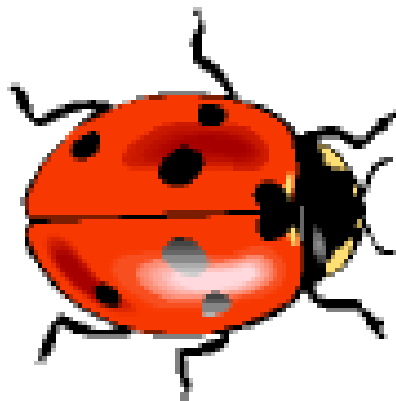
Ugly Bug Ball.
