A split digraph is two vowel letters, split, making one sound e.g. a-e as in *make* and i-e as in *site*.

Please can you read through the split digraph words below with your child and see if they can think of any more (maybe by looking in books, on posters etc...). The children can then practise writing some sentences, using words that contain split digraphs.
