End of KS2 Assessment Results 2016

2016 was the first year of the new system for SATs. This year only 53% of year 6 pupils nationally obtained the expected level in Reading, Writing and Maths combined. The expected standard was considerably higher this year than in any previous years.

Below is a summary of our results for this year. We were very pleased overall especially in terms of progress in all subjects
